Delivery Period

This is a self paced course with a face to face component as well as additional learning and assessment outside this time in order to gather the foundational knowledge that underpins the content and to meet the volume of learning as specified by the Australian Qualification framework [AQF]. Approximate time for completion is between 6-12 months depending on the learner and their individual circumstance.

Recognition of Prior Learning

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is conducted for experienced workers seeking to have their current skills and knowledge acknowledged. The RPL process requires the collection of evidence documents to support the determined outcome.

Credit Transfer

Credit Transfer is available and free of charge if the learner currently already holds a unit of competency and can provide evidence documents.

Award


On successful completion of all units of competency and course requirements, the learner will be awarded the RII20120 Certificate II in Resources and Infrastructure Work Preparation.
